SWIM Stream Buffers in Victoria Bay

As you all know, Victoria Bay is fortunate enough to back up to Lake Norman. We get to enjoy a beautiful trail around the lake, and many of our homes have water views. In exchange, we are responsible for maintaining the quality of the water by taking care of the SWIM Stream Buffer that surrounds the lake. From Mecklenburg County's website...

The purpose of the S.W.I.M. stream buffer network in Charlotte and Mecklenburg County is to ensure that the stream and adjacent lands will fulfill their natural functions. Stream systems are comprised of the stream and their drainage basins. Streams have the primary natural functions of conveying storm and ground water, storing floodwater and supporting aquatic and other life. Vegetated lands adjacent to the stream channel in the drainage basin serve as a "buffer" to protect the stream system's ability to fulfill its natural functions. Primary natural functions of the buffer include:

- Protect water quality by filtering pollutants;
- Provide storage for floodwaters;
- Allow channels to meander naturally;
- Provide suitable habitats for wildlife;
- Provide shade to reduce water temperatures; and
- Provide soil stability through root mass.

The SWIM Buffers are not permitted to be disturbed in any way, including mowing, clearing, tree removal, fertilizing, or dumping of vegetation such as grass clippings. Anyone who disturbs the SWIM Buffers is in violation of the Zoning Ordinance and can be punished with a fine. Please help us maintain our natural amenities by leaving the buffer areas alone and reporting any violations either to the HOA Board or directly to the Mecklenburg County Water Quality Program at 704-336-5500.

Keep in mind that all property that surrounds the lake is owned either by the Victoria Bay HOA or by the apartment complex. No one who owns a home in Victoria Bay has waterfront property and is, thus, not permitted to store personal items (boats, boat ramps, etc.) on that land. Items will be towed at the owners' expense.

Keeping Our Neighborhood Safe

- Don't leave miscellaneous items, especially valuables or electronics, in you car.
- Turn on your car alarm if you have one.
- Keep your garage doors closed at all times.
- Install motion sensor lights or leave your porch light on at night.
- Report any thefts to the Cornelius Police Department at 704-892-1363.
- Report unlit street lights to Electricities at 704-948-0550.
- Keep an eye on your neighbors' houses if they are out of town.
- Report any suspicious activity in the neighborhood by calling 911. When you call 911 from Victoria Bay, the call goes directly to the Cornelius Police Communications Center. This is the number Chief Hoyle has asked us to call anytime we want an officer to report to the neighborhood.
